
## LIFE AT CAMPSITE

## TO BE RESPECTED

Wearing the bracelet is mandatory

Swimming shorts are not allowed in the pool.

Wood and charcoal barbecues are not allowed.

Please respect the sorting of garbage.

Silence must be respected at night.

Category 1 dogs are not allowed. Category 2 dogs must be muzzled. Dogs must always be kept on a leash (not allowed on the beach) and their waste must be collected and disposed of in the garbage cans provided.



The different Clubs are only open in July and August.

## Waste Management

Short supply circuits, energy, water, recycling... everything counts!

We have been striving at Méditerranée Plage for several years to apply a principle that is dear to us: Respect for our planet.

The catchphrase *my campsite* **w** *my planet* is the leitmotif that signals the actions or places going in the direction of this approach.

Some actions carried out within our campsite:

- · **Recycling** place for Technical Service
- · Recycle bins in mobile homes,
- · Shower faucets for water saving,
- · Laundry with machines to ecological standards,
- Provision of eco-labeled detergent and soap,
- · Charging stations for electric cars,
- · Training of campsite staff in environmental issues and eco-gestures,
- · Creation of a shop with local products and short supply circuits,
- · Restaurants that are committed to an **environmentally friendly** approach.

This year, we're getting into **composting**. A bet on everyone's commitment to **transforming our food waste into biological nutrients** for our soils (see page 13).

# ELECTRIC CHARGING

For some time now, we have been installing **charging stations** for your electric vehicles. It is essential to only use these terminals for your vehicles.

## You make the difference!



Although holidays are a time for relaxation and carefree living, we rely on everyone's **commitment** for today's environmental issues.


This year, **water** is obviously at the top of our list of concerns. Our campsite is fed by a water table that has been **weakened** this year. In order to preserve this **precious resource**, we have postponed the opening of some of the pools until the end of May.

We therefore ask you to **manage your water consumption**, particularly with regard to the duration of showers and taps that run unnecessarily. Of course, **washing vehicles is totally forbidden**, and the use of the **hosepipes** is strictly **reserved for fire emergencies**.

On the other hand, as energy costs have exploded, we ask you to be reasonable on the use of air conditioning:

Do not leave the air conditioning on when you are away from the mobile home (10 minutes is enough to lower the temperature) and limit the exaggerated temperature differences between the outside and inside.

## COMPOSTING OF ORGANIC WASTE

## Let's give a second life to our food residues

Together, we can make an even greater contribution to the reduction of waste and its recycling.

This year, as a first experiment, **compost buckets** are available in some mobile homes. If you wish to participate and for those whose rentals are not equipped, you can get them at the reception.

A few precautions as shown in the following illustration will help you to fill your compost bucket with the best food residues! Afterwards, all you have to do is go to the compost area (18) to make **quality compost** together, which will contribute to nutrient for our fields and other local cultivations!



## COMPOSTING AREA

instructions for depositing your compostable waste.



Empty your food waste bucket. (respecting the sorting instructions)



Spread on top.



Cover with wood chips (middle bin).



Rinse your bucket if necessary.

## RENTALS On annival:

The handing over of the keys is scheduled at 4pm, and 10am for short stays.

A deposit of 200 € will be required (credit card), except or KIWI Pass holders.

Any possible anomalies noted on arrival must be reported at the Accommodation Office (see map (4))

### On departure:

The accommodation must be vacated before 10 am and before 6 pm for short stays.

The accommodation must be left clean, or you have the possibility to subscribe to the cleaning option for an amount of 75 € (-20% KIWI Pass). This option does not include the cleaning of the dishes, nor the removal of waste. To be booked at the latest 48 hours before your departure.

In all cases, please make an appointment at the reception indicating your departure time for the check of your accommodation. Outside the opening hours of the reception, you can leave the key in the yellow mailbox located on the front side at the entrance of the supermarket. Your deposit will be deleted once we have checked the accommodation.

## Cleaning procedure

In order to ensure the best possible end of your stay and to allow the next arrivals to take possession of their accommodation in time, please vacate your accommodation before 10 am on the day of your departure and before 6 pm for short stays.

Please remember to clean and tidy up:

- All the household appliances: The microwave, the refrigerator (remember to defrost it when you leave), the hotplates, the extractor hood, the coffee maker...
- · Furniture and sofa
- All dishes and cleaning utensils (basin, broom, wastebasket)
- · Empty your waste and garbage bags
- The bathroom (shower cubicle and door, mirror, washbasin and the 2 drains)
- The WC
- · Bedding (duvet, pillows, mattress).
- · The floor (without forgetting under the beds)
- The terrace and garden furniture (sun loungers, tables and chairs)

For your comfort, vacuum cleaners are available on loan at the accommodation service office.

Your deposit will be deleted once we have checked the accommodation.



Pitches are available from 2pm and must be vacated by 12 noon.

A deposit of 50€ for the loan of all equipment such as adapters, extension leads... will be required, except for KIWI Pass holders.

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Although unlikely, partial or total flooding of the campground could occur in the event of very heavy rain and require evacuation.

All campers will be notified, by loud-speaker or any other means of rising water and will be ordered to evacuate if necessary.

In such circumstances, stay calm and follow the instructions carefully:

## In case of emergency:

- · Low season: Call the phone number on the right side of the reception.
- High season: alert the security guard at the entrance to the campsite.

## In case of an alert: Put away your equipment

- Stay tuned for further instructions.

If you are without a car or have any difficulty, let the reception know.

## In case of evacuation:

- Follow the instructions of the campsite's security team.
- Take your vehicle and join the A9 and A75 motorways by exchangers 34 and 35 by way of Portiragnes.

Consult the evacuation plan of the campsite next to the reception desk.

Evacuation routes are symbolised by this logo:



For people who are not autonomous (without a car), the regrouping area is provided next to the reception.
